

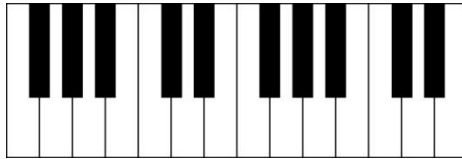
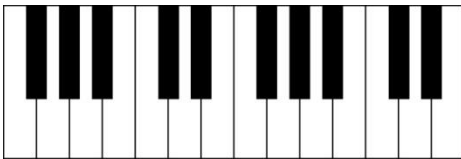
“How To Learn The 12 Major Chords” Instructional Guide

With a pen or marker mark the notes that make up each chord for the four visual chord groups. Place an X on white keys and circle the black keys. Then take them to your piano and learn each group.

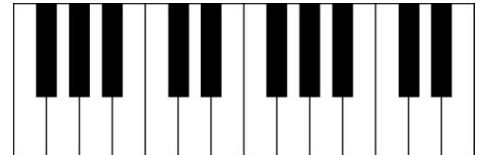
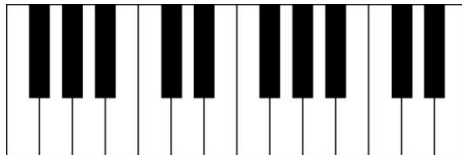
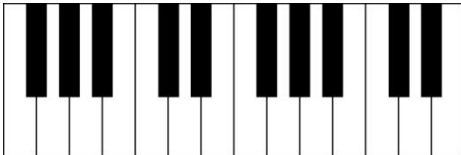

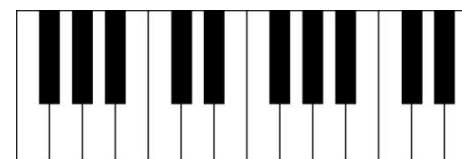
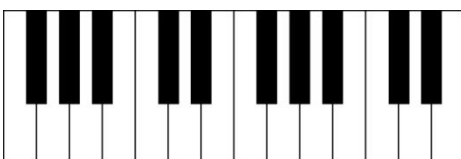
“Blackberry Jam Sandwich chords”

Refer back to the “Finding a Major Chord on the Piano” page if you get stumped trying to identify the Major Chords. Remember that the 12 Major Chords are organized into four groups of three.

Once you successfully have the 12 Major Chords marked on this sheet, sit down at your keyboard and learn each group visually by playing them; preferably with your right hand. The real secret to learning these 12 Major Chords is through repetition and visualization. Repetition by a slow precise movement in your hand and being able to visualize the chord even when you’re not looking at the keyboard is the key to learning them as quickly and easily as possible. -
